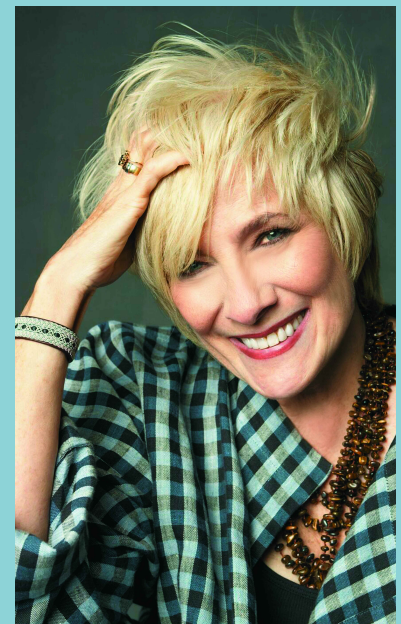

Betty Buckley is one of only a handful of women who can be referred to as a real Broadway star and a true legend. Her very first audition in New York, back in 1969, landed her in the Broadway musical *1776*, her first of many to come. She won the coveted Tony Award® for her portrayal of Grizabella in the Original Broadway Cast of *Cats* and has appeared in many shows, including Andrew Lloyd Webber’s *Sunset Boulevard*, both in London’s West End and on Broadway. She has acted in many films and starred on television, and is a three-time Grammy® Award nominee.

In 2007, Buckley returned to the recording studio with her longtime friend and collaborator jazz great Kenny Werner. Having enjoyed a nearly 18-year working relationship performing sold-out shows around the world, together they recorded *Quintessence*—a hypnotic album drawn from the Jazz, Standards, Brazilian music and Musical Theatre song book. It is her masterful interpretation of this kind of vast and eclectic repertoire that makes Buckley one of the most spellbinding and engaging performers today.
